

Sires at the Sale

The following is an abbreviated statistical rundown of stallions represented in this year's Del Mar Yearling Sale.

AFFIRMED (Exclusive Native) Deceased, 2001

Progeny earnings of **\$40,893,923**/Average earnings per starter of **\$69,547**.

Last horse to win the Triple Crown and the first to surpass \$2 million in earnings. He is the sire of 77 stakes winners and 11 champions, including \$2.5 million earner Flawlessly and Canadian Triple Crown champion Peteski. Affirmed was represented by nine stakes horses in 2000.

ALYDEED (Shaded) Windfields Farm, Canada

Progeny earnings of **\$7,480,257**/Average earnings per starter of **\$40,434**.

A major stakes winner in his own right, Alydeed captured Canada's classic Queen's Plate and ran second in the Preakness for earnings of \$930,689. His stakes winners include Primally, Canada's champion juvenile filly in 1997. Sales yearlings by him averaged \$131,250 in 2000.

BATONNIER (His Majesty) Victory Rose Thoroughbreds, Vacaville, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$9,440,093**/Average earnings per starter of **\$40,171**.

Sire of Cavonnier, California's Horse of the Year in 1996, and California champions Batroyale and Charm a Gendarme (dam of multiple grade I winner Tout Charmant). Among California's leading sires.

BENCHMARK (Alydar) River Edge Farm, Buellton, CA

Represents the same sire (Raise a Native) and broodmare sire (Danzig) lines as 2000 Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus. This grade II winner of \$636,707 has his first crop of yearlings selling this year.

BERTRANDO (Skywalker) River Edge Farm, Buellton, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$8,676,451**/Average earnings per starter of **\$54,569**.

Sired the sale toppers at Del Mar in 1999 and 2000. Last year, eight Bertrando yearlings grossed \$733,000 and averaged \$91,625 to lead all other sires at Del Mar. His stakes-winning offspring include Smooth Player, Stormy Jack, Cliquot and Here's to You.

BOONE'S MILL (Carson City) Southwest Stallion Station, TX

Progeny earnings of **\$1,652,355**/Average earnings per starter of **\$17,767**.

Winner of grade II Sapling Stakes and \$400,214 in earnings. With just three crops of racing age, he is the sire of stakes-winning Paso Palma and Boone's Breeze.

BORN WILD (Wild Again) Hideaway Farms, San Jacinto, CA

A stakes winner in Austria and North America with earnings of \$259,505, Born Wild hails from the female family of Allez France and Priceless Gem. His first foals are yearlings this season.

CANDY STRIPES (Blushing Groom (Fr)) Standing in Argentina

Progeny earnings of **\$4,456,468**/Average earnings per starter of **\$44,123**.

A leading stallion in Argentina, he is the sire of champion Different, a grade I winner of \$1,349,802 in the U. S., and 23 other stakes winners. His first American foals are 3-year-olds this season.

CEE'S TIZZY (Relaunch) Harris Farms, Coalinga, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$14,711,624**/Average earnings per starter of **\$91,377**.

Among the nation's leading sires in 2001, he is represented by 2000 Breeders' Cup champion and Horse of the Year Tiznow. His other graded stakes winners California champion Budroyale, Theresa's Tizzy ad Gourmet Girl, the latter a Del Mar sale graduate of 1996 and winner of this year's grade I Apple Blossom H.

CLEVER TRICK (Icecapade) Glencrest Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$37,936,348**/Average earnings per starter of **\$53,582**.

The sire of influential Phone Trick and California stallion Tricky Creek, Clever Trick has been represented by 58 stakes winners through 2000. His well-sought after yearlings have averaged \$48,814 during the last three years.

COBRA KING (Farma Way) Gainesway Farms, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$432,386**/Average earnings per starter of **\$15,442**.

Among the nation's leading juveniles in 1995 when he earned \$211,825 and defeated Hennessy in the gr. II Hollywood Prevue Breeders' Cup Stakes. His first crop reached the races in 2000 and include 16 winners so far.

CRAFTY PROSPECTOR (Mr. Prospector) Brookdale Farms, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$56,697,823**/Average earnings per starter of **\$93,561**.

Mr. Prospector's leading active son by U. S. progeny earnings and percentage of stakes winners, Crafty Prospector consistently ranks among North America's leading stallions. He has over 75 stakes winners and earners of more than \$55 million.

CRYPTOCLEARANCE (Fappiano) Margaux Farms, Ky

Progeny earnings of **\$22,707,545**/Average earnings per starter of **\$51,608**.

Represents the sire line responsible for classic winners Unbridled, Real Quiet and Red Bullet. Cryptoclearance himself is the sire of 1998 Belmont winner Victory Gallop and is represented this year by Blue Grass Stakes winner Millennium Wind. Among the nation's leading sires.

DANCE FLOOR (Star de Naskra) Blooming Hills, Clements, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$2,207,237**/Average earnings per starter of **\$40,875**.

A multiple graded stakes winner of \$863,329, Dance Floor was one of the leaders of his generation at 2 and 3. He has gotten off to a fast start at stud, siring graded stakes winners Dancing Daze, O'Malleys Boy and Doyle in New Zealand. His first American crop are yearlings this season.

DEHERE (Deputy Minister) Shizunai Stallion Station, Japan

Progeny earnings of **\$8,342,743**/Average earnings per starter of **\$50,870**.

Became the first 2-year-old to sweep Saratoga's series of Sanford, Saratoga Special and Hopeful Stakes. His roster of stakes winners include Graeme Hall, Arrested Dreams, Her She Kisses and Millencolin.

DISTINCTIVE CAT (Storm Cat) Applebite Farms, French Camp, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$159,102**/Average earnings per starter of **\$8,839**.

Sire of the filly Distinctive Wish who brought \$150,000 at Del Mar last year. This unraced son of influential Storm Cat is off to a quick start at stud, with stakes-placed Rocky's Crew and several other winners in his first crop.

DISTORTED HUMOR (Forty Niner) Winstar Farm, Ky.

A record-setting multiple stakes winner of \$769,964, Distorted Humor is bred along similar lines as Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus. He set a new track record of 1:21 for 7 furlongs at Churchill Downs. His first foals are yearlings this season.

EASTERN ECHO (Damascus) Lane's End Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$12,074,834**/Average earnings per starter of **\$55,902**.

Undefeated winner of the important Futurity Stakes at Belmont Park, he descends from a female family that has produced 1993 Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero and many other good ones. Eastern Echo has sired over 10 stakes winners, including the promising young California stallion Swiss Yodeler.

EDITOR'S NOTE (Forty Niner) Overbrook Farm, Ky.

The classic-winning son of Forty Niner showed top form at 2 and 3 by finishing third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and defeating Skip Away and Louis Quatorze in the 1996 Belmont Stakes. His first foals are 2-year-olds this season.

END SWEEP (Forty Niner) Shadai Stallion Station, Japan

Progeny earnings of **\$12,203,496**/Average earnings per starter of **\$74,412**.

Sire of recent grade I winners Trippi and Nany's Sweep among 16 North American stakes winners, End Sweep won or placed in 15 of 18 starts for earnings of \$372,433.

FALSTAFF (Lyphard) Creston Farms, Creston, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$9,094,122**/Average earnings per starter of **\$39,199**.

Among California's leading stallions, Falstaff is the sire of two-time California champion Cover Gal and multiple gr. III winner Go Go, both graduates of the 1998 Del Mar sale. He is also represented by New Mexico stakes winner Brew, who currently has 11 stakes victories and earnings of nearly \$300,000.

FLYING CONTINENTAL (Flying Paster) Harris Farms, Coalinga, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$5,284,237**/Average earnings per starter of **\$29,854**.

A major selling power at Del Mar in recent years, he was the leading sire at the 1998 sale. Among California's leading stallions, Flying Continental was represented by 13 stakes horses in 2000.

FLYING VICTOR (Flying Paster) Blooming Hills, Clements, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$4,410,973**/Average earnings per starter of **\$29,020**.

Another stakes-winning son of California's legendary Flying Paster, Flying Victor has turned into an outstanding sire of precocious young horses. His stakes winners include Flying In the Lane and Wired to Fly.

FORMAL GOLD (Black Tie Affair (Ire)) Gainesway Farms, Ky.

A multiple grade I winner with earnings of more than \$1.5 million, Formal Gold defeated champion Skip Away in the Woodward and Iselin Handicaps in 1997. Winner also of the Donn and Brooklyn Handicaps, his first foals are yearlings this season.

GAME PLAN (Danzig) Rancho San Miguel, San Miguel, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$242,686**/Average earnings per starter of **\$14,276**.
Unraced Danzig son out of a grade I stakes-winning full sister to Easy Goer, Game Plan relocated to California for the 2001 breeding season. His son Bills Paid is graded stakes-placed as a sophomore this season.

GENERAL MEETING (Seattle Slew) Golden Eagle Farm, Ramona, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$13,153,030**/Average earnings per starter of **\$100,405**.
Ranked among the nation's leading sires in 2000, General Meeting's runners earned more than \$3.3 million last year and included 11 stakes horses, led by the grade I-winning full siblings General Meeting and Notable Career. A filly by him sold for \$100,000 at Del Mar last year.

GO FOR GIN (Cormorant) Claiborne Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$3,377,109**/Average earnings per starter of **\$58,226**.
With just three crops of racing age, 1994 Kentucky Derby winner Go for Gin has sent out multiple grade I winner Albert the Great and international stakes performer Curule. He has sold 70 yearlings for an average of \$46,144.

GOLD FEVER (Forty Niner) Lane's End Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$728,251**/Average earnings per starter of **\$26,972**.
From the family of influential sire Exclusive Native, Gold Fever was a leading first crop sire in 2000 with 2-year-old stakes winners Gold Mover and Golden Hurricane. He has sold 58 yearlings for an average of \$70,559.

HALF TERM (Mr. Prospector) Golden Eagle Farm, Ramona, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$1,045,135**/Average earnings per starter of **\$29,861**.
With only three crops at the races, he is quickly establishing himself as one of California's top young stallions. Half Term is the sire of stakes winners Shining Nuggets, Wingless Flight and Service Term.

HALORY HUNTER (Jade Hunter) Lane's End Farm, Ky.

Winner of the 1998 Blue Grass Stakes and \$713,120 in earnings, Halory Hunter is a half-brother to stakes winners Prory, Brushed Halory and Key Lory. His first foals are yearlings this season.

HELMSMAN (El Gran Senor) Pegasus Ranch, Petaluma, CA

A multiple graded stakes winner of more than \$1 million on dirt and turf, Helmsman relocated to California for the 2001 breeding season. His first crop included a yearling that sold for \$115,000 on the West Coast in 2000, and a pair of 2-year-olds that brought six-figure prices in Florida earlier this year.

HIGH BRITE (Best Turn) Harris Farms, Coalinga, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$15,384,789**/Average earnings per starter of **\$44,985**.
Among California's leading stallions, High Brite is the sire of 2001 stakes winners Beyond Brilliant and Brighton Belle. He consistently ranks among the top-selling stallions at Del Mar.

HONOUR AND GLORY (Relaunch) Ashford Stud, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$2,385,714**/Average earnings per starter of **\$45,013**.
The nation's leading freshman sire in 2000, Honour and Glory sent out Caressing to win both the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the vote as North America's champion 2-year-old filly. He's had 107 yearlings sell for an average of \$84,972, which included a \$75,000 purchase at Del Mar last year.

HOUSTON (Seattle Slew) Getaway Thoroughbred Farm, Romoland, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$11,421,075**/Average earnings per starter of **\$33,991**.
Among California's leading stallions, Houston is a \$2.9 million Keeneland sales yearling who has turned into an outstanding sire with 25 stakes horses.

IN EXCESS (IRE) (Siberian Express) Vessels Stallion Farm, Bonsall, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$8,176,235**/Average earnings per starter of **\$56,002**.
Among California's leading stallions, In Excess was represented by five state champions in his first five crops. Known for siring precocious young runners, he has sent out Indian Charlie, In Excessive Bull, Controlled, Ex Marks the Cop and recent Snow Chief Stakes winner Romanceishope.

INDIAN CHARLIE (In Excess (Ire)) Vinery, Ky

He won the 1998 Santa Anita Derby in stakes record time in just his fourth career start and then followed the example of previous Cal-breds Swaps and T. V. Lark by going to stud in Kentucky. His first foals are yearlings this season.

IZ A SAROS (Saros (GB)) Legacy Ranch, Chino, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$694,962**/Average earnings per starter of **\$21,059**.
Stakes-winning full brother to California champion Fran's Valentine, Iz a Saros is the sire of multiple stakes winner Iza Bon Bon and many other good runners.

JADE HUNTER (Mr. Prospector) Diamond A Farms, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$19,960,627**/Average earnings per starter of **\$58,708**.
Another top stallion by the influential Mr. Prospector, Jade Hunter has sired 29 stakes winners, including Yagli, Stuka, Halory Hunter and Diazo. Yearlings by him averaged \$220,000 in 2000, including a top price of \$400,000.

JUDGE T C (Judge Smells) Airdrie Stud, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$916,325**/Average earnings per starter of **\$18,327**.
Among the nation's leading first-year sires in 2000, Judge T C was represented by 11 juvenile winners and three stakes horses through last October. Out of the Secretariat mare I'm Pretty, he hails from the family of champions Dr. Fager and Ta Wee.

LANGFUHR (Danzig) Vinery, Ky.

By the influential Danzig, Langfuhr won at distances from seven furlongs to 1 1/8 miles and captured the Vosburgh Stakes, and Forego, Metropolitan and Carter Handicaps, to be voted Canada's champion sprinter in 1996. His first crop, who averaged over \$21,000 in the sale ring last year, are 2-year-olds this season and already include one winner.

LIT DE JUSTICE (El Gran Senor) Adena Springs, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$680,506**/Average earnings per starter of **\$13,888**.
Voted North America's champion sprinter of 1996 when he won the Breeders' Cup Sprint and three other graded stakes in California. Among the nation's leading first crop sires in 2000, he was represented by 11 juvenile winners, including stakes winner Lit a Fire and stakes-placed Our Magistrate.

MARIA'S MON (Wavering Monarch) Pin Oak Stud, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$3,026,077**/Average earnings per starter of **\$58,194**.
Sire of 2001 Kentucky Derby winner Monarchos in his first crop, champion Maria's Mon was the only 2-year-old to win multiple grade I's in 1995. He possesses the same Raise a Native/Caro cross that also produced Unbridled's Song and Red Bullet.

MEADOWLAKE (Hold Your Peace) Darby Dan Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$27,823,159**/Average earnings per starter of **\$70,084**.
Consistently ranked among the nation's leading sires, Meadowlake has been represented by champion Meadow Star, \$838,595-earner Meafara and Champagne Stakes winner Greenwood Lake. He was represented by eight stakes winners in 2000 and a \$750,000 yearling at Keeneland in September.

MEMO (CHI) (Mocito Guapo) Ridgeley Farm, Hemet, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$2,433,157**/Average earnings per starter of **\$45,058**.
A champion in Chile and a multiple stakes winner in the U. S., he is the sire of a \$117,000 filly at the 1999 Del Mar sale. Memo's stakes winners include La Feminn, Grey Memo and Guillermo. Among California's leading stallions.

MINER'S MARK (Mr. Prospector) Dunhill Stud, Fla.

Progeny earnings of **\$3,981,356**/Average earnings per starter of **\$38,654**.
Produced from undefeated champion Personal Ensign, Miner's Mark is a full brother to 2001 stakes winner Traditionally. Winner of the Jockey Gold Cup and Jim Dandy Stakes in 1993, he has sired stakes winners Call Me Up and Undermine and had a colt sell for \$310,000 at Keeneland's September sale.

MOUNTAIN CAT (Storm Cat) Izmit Pension Stud, Turkey

Progeny earnings of **\$8,184,308**/Average earnings per starter of **\$41,971**.
Among the first stakes winners sired by the influential Storm Cat, Mountain Cat was a top juvenile in 1992 and compiled single season earnings of \$1,460,627. His stakes winners include Classic Cat, Mountain Range and Asher.

MR. GREELEY (Gone West) Dixiana Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$4,038,346**/Average earnings per starter of **\$41,208**.
A top-ranked 3-year-old sprinter of 1995, he was one of North America's leading second-crop sires of 2000 with stakes winners El Corredor, Lucky Livi and Lovewithoutend. Mr. Greeley was the sire of a \$270,000 colt at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky yearling sale last year.

MR PURPLE (Deputy Minister) Victory Rose Thoroughbreds, Vacaville, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$116,007**/Average earnings per starter of **\$29,002**.
Winner of the 1996 Santa Anita Handicap and \$1,133,538 in earnings, Mr Purple is by the sire of champions Open Mind, Go for Wand and Dehere. His first foals are 3-year-olds this season and he is already the sire of two juvenile winners in his second crop.

NOT TRICKY (Phone Trick) Ken Arnold Ranch, Stockton, CA


By the sire of champions Favorite Trick and Phone Chatter, Not Tricky won or placed in six of eight starts for earnings of \$123,225 and ran second to Coronado's Quest in the 1997 Cowdin Stakes. His first foals are yearlings this season.

OLYMPIO (Naskra) JZ Stock Farm, Temecula, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$9,394,226**/Average earnings per starter of **\$54,618**. 

Led by the brilliant filly Olympic Charmer, Olympio sent out nine stakes winners in 2000. Relocated to California for the 2000 breeding season, his first California crop of foals arrived this year. Among the state's leading stallions.

OPEN FORUM (Deputy Minister) Mockingbird Farm, Fla.

Defeated the very fast Crypto Star in the 1997 Risen Star Stakes and compiled earnings of \$147,539. Open Forum's first foals are 2-year-olds this season and number four winners, including one in stakes company to date.

PENTELICUS (Fappiano) Ocala Stud Farm, Fla.)

Progeny earnings of **\$13,046,426**/Average earnings per starter of **\$45,143**.

Also from the potent Fappiano sire line and bred along similar lines as Unbridled, Pentelicus won or placed 19 of 37 starts for earnings of \$267,742. His stakes winners include Pent Up Kiss, Cuvee Brut and Riley's Heat.

PINE BLUFF (Danzig) Lane's End Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$10,654,745**/Average earnings per starter of **\$62,675**.

Full brother to the dam of Fusaichi Pegasus, he captured the 1992 Preakness Stakes and earned \$2,255,884. Sire of graded stakes winners Lil's Lad and I Ain't Bluffing, plus 101 yearlings that averaged \$50,382.

PRIZED (Kris S.) Dixiana Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$9,521,871**/Average earnings per starter of **\$44,914**.

Grade I winner on both coasts, won the 1989 Breeders' Cup Turf and earned \$2,262,555. By the Roberto line stallion Kris S., Prized is the sire of 30 stakes horses, including Cal-bred stakes winners Turkish Prize and Bright Magic.

ROY (Fappiano) Darby Dan Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$5,989,492**/Average earnings per starter of **\$27,102**.

A top stallion in Chile, Roy is the sire of 55 known stakes winners. His 54 North American-bred yearlings have averaged \$43,093 through 2000.

RUN SOFTLY (Deputy Minister) Hill 'n' Dale Farm, Ky.

He carried 117 pounds while defeating eventual Breeders' Cup Classic winner Alphabet Soup in the grade III Volante Handicap as a 3-year-old. He has won over all surfaces and earned \$214,121. His first foals are 2-year-olds this season.

SAINT BALLADO (Halo) Taylor Made Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$10,933,134**/Average earnings per starter of **\$61,079**.


From 5 crops to race, he has been represented by stakes winners Yankee Victor, Flame Thrower, Captain Bodgit and National Saint. In 2000, a Saint Ballado colt equaled the highest priced 2-year-old of all time at \$2 million and he had yearlings fetch prices of \$1.4 million and \$1 million.

SAROS (GB) (Sassafras (Fr)) Circle H Ranch, Murrieta, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$11,600,160**/Average earnings per starter of **\$39,727**. 

Among California's leading stallions, Saros first came to national attention when his daughter Fran's Valentine was disqualified from a victory in the 1984 Breeders' Cup and later became the first Cal-bred filly to win the historic Kentucky Oaks. Sire also of Saros Brig, He's a Saros and Iz a Saros.

SIBERIAN SUMMER (Siberian Express) Special T Thoroughbreds, Temecula, CA

Grade I winner by the sire of In Excess, he captured the 1993 Charles H. Strub Stakes for earnings of \$501,615. His first foals are 2-year-olds this season and already include two winners. 

SIPHON (BRZ) (Itajara) Airdrie Stud, Ky.

Graded stakes winner in his native Brazil and North America, he captured the Hollywood Gold Cup and Santa Anita Handicap for earnings of \$3,155,919. He's had 31 yearlings sell for an average of \$128,210. Siphon's first crop of 2-year-olds have already produced a winner this season.

SIR CAT (Storm Cat) Gainesway Farms, Ky.

A multiple graded stakes winner of \$401,185 on both dirt and turf, he has more graded stakes wins than any other Storm Cat son. His first foals are 2-year-olds this season and already number a winner amongst them.

SLEWPY (Seattle Slew) Flag Is Up Farms, Solvang, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$15,741,177**/Average earnings per starter of **\$47,846**. 

Currently ranked among North America's leading turf sires of 2001 and is one of California's leading stallions. He is represented by 2001 stakes stars Road to Slew, Rare Charmer and Hangonslewpyhangon. He also sired 1992 Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Thirty Slews and \$680,963-earner Surachai.

SMOKE GLACKEN (Two Punch) Gainesway Farms, Ky.

Extremely fast runner in a crop that featured Silver Charm, Touch Gold, Richter Scale and Free House. He was voted Eclipse Champion Sprinter in 1997. Smoke Glacken's first crop of yearlings sold last year for an average of \$60,321 and as 2-year-olds this season, already include a stakes winner.

SMOKESTER (Never Tabled) Cardiff Stud Farms, Atascadero, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$5,469,051**/Average earnings per starter of **\$124,297**. 

Among California's leading stallions, Smokester has an average earnings index of 5.59. His foals are led by Free House, two-time California-bred Horse of the Year, 1999 Cal Cup Classic winner Bagshot, and Channing Way, winner of the Melair Stakes at Gold Rush II.

STORM BOOT (Storm Cat) Crestwood Farm, Ky.

Progeny earnings of **\$6,828,182**/Average earnings per starter of **\$56,902**.

From the family of leading sires Nureyev, Sadler's Wells and Fairy King, Storm Boot was represented by eight stakes horses in 2000. His graded stakes winners are led by Bourbon Belle, Hurricane Bertie and American Spirit.

SWISS YODELER (Eastern Echo) Pepper Oaks Farm, Santa Ynez, CA

He went undefeated in his first five races and captured the grade I Hollywood Futurity at two. He has the highest live foal percentage (86%) among California stallions bred to 50 or more mares in 1999. His first foals are yearlings this season.

TACTICAL ADVANTAGE (Forty Niner) Marablue Farm, Fla.

Progeny earnings of **\$6,099,993**/Average earnings per starter of **\$49,593**.


A grade II stakes winner out of an exceptional female family that produced Easy Goer, Sea Hero and Personality. Sired stakes winners Prime Directive, Forty One Carats and Danish Dynamite in his first crop.

TURKOMAN (Alydar) Circle H Ranch, Murrieta, CA

VALID WAGER (Valid Appeal) Tommy Town Thoroughbreds, Santa Ynez, CA

Progeny earnings of **\$1,105,840**/Average earnings per starter of **\$29,101**. 

Among the leading first-crop sires in the country last year, Valid Wager relocated to California for the 2001 breeding season. His first crop includes the stakes performers Major Wager, Tonights Wager and Showy Wager.


VAUDEVILLE (Theatrical (Ire)) Tommy Town Thoroughbreds, Santa Ynez, CA

Multiple graded stakes winner of \$604,350, Vaudeville captured the 1994 American Derby and Secretariat Stakes on the turf. He sold five yearlings from his first crop last year for an average of \$34,080, including a filly that brought \$70,000 at Del Mar. 


VICTORY SPEECH (Deputy Minister) Ashford Stud, Ky.

One of the outstanding members of a crop that included Skip Away, Unbridled's Song and Honour and Glory, Victory Speech captured the Swaps, Dwyer and Strub Stakes for earnings of \$1,289,020. His first foals are 2-year-olds this season.


WESTERN FAME (Gone West) Applebite Farms, French Camp, CA

From the potent Mr. Prospector sire line, he hails from a stakes-producing family.  A winner in England and North America, Western Fame won or placed in 16 races for earnings of \$402,484. His first foals are yearlings this season.

WILD DEPUTY (Wild Again) Valley Creek Farm, Valley Center, CA

By a top sire out of the female family of champion Numbered Account, Wild Deputy is a stakes winner of \$202,690. His first foals are yearlings this season. 

WILD GOLD (Wild Again) Pegasus Ranch, Petaluma, CA

Captured six stakes races and \$456,726, including the 1995 California Cup Sprint,  Wild Gold has won at distances from 6 furlongs to 1 1/16 miles.
