The Foundation awarded its annual \$5,000 scholarships to Amber Domino and Elaine Hu, undergraduates at the U. C. Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, at an awards ceremony at the school in mid-May. Present for the ceremony were Foundation president Jeanne L. Canty, secretary Jane Goldstein, and trustees Rod Pitts and Greg Ferraro, D.V.M. Dr. Ferraro is the director of the Center for Equine Health at Davis.

Ms. Domino is a graduate of the University of Arizona in veterinary

science and has a 3.54 grade point average at Davis. She was a National Merit Scholar and Arizona Regents Scholar. She has taken part in three-day eventing and is active in the Equine Medicine Club/Student Chapter and the Student Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care Society.

Ms. Hu earned a B.S. in animal science from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, and graduated Cum Laude. She maintains a 3.48 grade point average at Davis. She enjoys horseback riding

and reining, as well as training horses. She was vice president of her class during her first year in vet school and was Foal Team member/coordinator.

Long-range plans for Ms. Domino include completing an internship in an equine referral practice, then studying for a board certificate in internal medicine. Ms. Hu will seek an internship working with performance horses, as she is interested in race horses and western performance horses. She also intends to complete a residency in equine surgery or reproduction.
